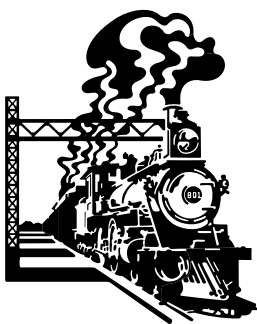


PTK Serves Lunch for Landscape & Garden Days
