

ADVISEMENT: WHAT'S YOUR GAME PLAN?

Advisement season for Spring 2011 is right around the corner. Here are some tips and tricks to make sure you get the classes you need and want:

- 1) Make an appointment with your major advisor and your QUEST advisor, now! Appointments for Spring registration fill quickly; as do the classes! If you meet with your major advisor make sure that you tell them you're a QUEST student, and you need a QUEST class.
- 2) Take or retake any placement tests you need.
- 3) Research majors and transfer schools if you are still undecided. Remember: the sooner you make a decision, the smoother the transfer.
- 4) If you are undecided on your major, try to decide on a general area that you are interested in or not interested in.
- 5) Look over the catalog and any program of study information you have. Have an idea of the classes that you need/want to take.



6) Think about your schedule for Spring Semester. When can you take classes? What works best for you? The more information you can give your advisor the easier their job will be.

7) Set up your wish list or register for classes*!

Community of Learning Ticket Policy: Did you know that QUEST students can get free tickets to area performances? Tickets are available on the first Monday of each month for events happening that month, or 2 weeks prior to the event if it takes place at the beginning of the month. Tickets are on a first come-first served-basis, and are limited to one event per month. However, a waiting list will be generated. If tickets are not claimed three days prior to an event, people on the waiting list will have the opportunity to claim tickets for that event. If you have signed up on the wait list for an extra ticket, it is your responsibility to check with the QUEST Staff three (3) days before the event.
