- Complete an ICC application.**
This can be done online at www.icc.edu or in the Student Records office, L211.
- Have your transcripts sent to ICC.** (Only if you're planning on earning a degree.)
If you are just graduating high school, ask your guidance counselor to send your transcripts.
If you have attended any other colleges or universities and plan to graduate from ICC, you will need to have those transcripts sent to ICC.
- Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).**
This can be done online at www.icc.edu or in the Financial Aid office, L209.
List Illinois Central College on the application. The federal school code for ICC is 006753.
- Contact the Testing Center for placement testing.**
Call 309/694-5234 for an appointment to take the math and reading placement tests.
- Arrange an appointment with an academic advisor.**

- Prepare for your appointment with your academic advisor.**
Obtain a college catalog to find out what academic programs are offered at ICC.
Look over your chosen academic program to discover what courses are required for your major.

- Meet with your academic advisor.**
Review your placement test scores, discuss your career plan, and plan your schedule of classes.
Be sure to bring your placement test scores, a list of courses you may want to take, and any other important information you want to discuss with your advisor.
- Follow through on any referrals suggested by your advisor.**
Call your advisor with any questions.
- Register for classes and purchase textbooks.**
