	Illinois Central College GPA of 2.0 or above (if you have attended ICC)
	Last college attended GPA of 2.0 or above or 18 hours of approved 'program' courses at ICC or other colleges with a grade of 'C' or better
	18 years of age by October 1 of the year of program entry
	1 year high school lab science including chemistry, biology or physics or equivalent college science ('C' or better)
	MAT 108 (intermediate algebra) with a "C" or better or placement into MATH 115 (college algebra)
