Discussion Board Postings - Points

Most discussion board postings will be graded according to the following rubrics. If a discussion board posting is going to be graded on an alternate rubric it will be provided. Weekly discussion board postings will be posted in the gradebook as "WK1DB", "WK2DB", etc.

Discussion Board Posts will be graded on a 3 point scale.

- 3 Points - The posting addressed all the required elements.
- 2 Points - The posting addressed 75% of the required elements.
- 1 Point - The posting addressed 50% of the required elements.
- 0 Points - The posting addressed less than 50% of the required elements.

Discussion Board Follow-Up/Reply postings will earn one point per post.

- 1 Point - The post contributed thoughtful and meaningful follow-up.
- 0 Points - The post did not contribute thoughtful and meaningful follow-up.



Discussion Forum Participation

Discussion forum participation will be an integral part of this course. "Participation" implies that you are not only reading and responding to the discussion forum prompt but you are also reading and responding to the postings made by your classmates.

The language, tone and formality of discussion postings must be at adult/higher education level. There will be no tolerance for disrespectful responses. The instructor reserves the right to remove postings at any time. Use complete sentences and avoid the use of "instant message" or "chat" abbreviations in discussion postings.
