## FAQs

**Q:** The bookstore ran out of copies of the textbook we were to use for the semester. Several students need to wait a week or two before the text arrives. Can I make copies of the first chapter so they are not behind?

**A:** Yes. As long as the text is ordered, you may make a copy of the needed chapters waiting for the arrival of the text.

**Q:** If a student cannot afford the text or workbook, can I make copies of it so the student needn't pay for the book?

**A:** No. This would clearly be copyright infringement. The fourth factor Fair Use is "the effect of the use upon the potential market for or value of the copyrighted work".

**Q:** I plan to overhaul my course packets this summer. Document Services cannot legally print copyrighted material unless it falls under Fair Use or I receive permission from the copyright holder. Can I receive help in either determining whether I can use Fair Use or in obtaining permission?

**A:** Yes. Markie can meet with you this semester, or over the summer, to review the packet and to seek permission if necessary.
