Many website require JavaScript to be enabled. This page shows how to do this in many popular computer platform and browser combinations.

Windows	Internet Explorer 5, 5.5, and 6	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Select "Tools" from the menu bar and click on "Internet Options...".</li><li>2. Click the "Security" tab and then click the "Custom Level..." button.</li><li>3. Scroll down to the Scripting category and select the "Enable" radio button for "Active Scripting".</li><li>4. Click the Yes button in the "Are you sure..." window.</li><li>5. Click the OK button.</li><li>6. Close this window and Click the Refresh button in the browser's row of icons.</li></ol>
Windows	Netscape Navigator 6+	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Select "Edit" from the menu bar and click on "Preferences".</li><li>2. Select the "Advanced" option.</li><li>3. Click on checkbox next to "Enable JavaScript for Navigator"</li><li>4. Click the "OK" button.</li><li>5. Close this window and Click the Reload button in the browser's row of icons.</li></ol>
Windows	Mozilla	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Select "Edit" from the menu bar and click on "Preferences".</li><li>2. Click on plus sign next to "Advanced" to show Advanced options.</li><li>3. Click on "Scripts &amp; Plugins".</li><li>4. Click on the checkbox next to "Navigator" under "Enable JavaScript for".</li><li>5. Click the "OK" button.</li><li>6. Close this window and Click the Reload button in the browser's row of icons.</li></ol>
Windows	Opera	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Select "File" from the menu bar and click on "Quick preferences".</li><li>2. Click on the checkbox next to "Enable JavaScript".</li><li>3. Close this window and Click the Reload button in the browser's row of icons.</li></ol>
Windows	America Online (AOL)	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Select "Settings".</li><li>2. Select "Preferences".</li><li>3. Select "Internet Properties".</li><li>4. Select "Custom Level".</li><li>5. Scroll down the Custom Level screen to "Scripting".</li><li>6. Enable "Active Scripting".</li><li>7. Select "Okay".</li><li>8. Select "Yes" that you want to change the security settings.</li><li>9. Select "Okay".</li><li>10. Close the Preference window.</li><li>11. Close this window and Click the Reload button in the browser's row of icons.</li></ol>

Select "Explorer" under OS X or "Edit" under earlier OSs from the menu bar and click on "Preferences...".</li><li>2. Click on triangle next to "Web Browser" to open sub-menu if needed.</li><li>3. Under "Active Content", click on checkbox next to "Enable Scripting"</li><li>4. Click the "OK" button.</li><li>5. Close this window and Click the Refresh button in the browser's row of icons.</li></ol>  |
| Macintosh Netscape 7.x          | <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Select "Netscape" under OS X or "Edit" under earlier OSs from the menu bar and click on "Preferences...".</li><li>2. Click on triangle next to "Advanced" to open sub-menu if needed.</li><li>3. Click on "Scripts &amp; Plugins".</li><li>4. Click on checkbox next to "Navigator" under "Enable JavaScript for".</li><li>5. Click the "OK" button.</li><li>6. Close this window and Click the Reload button in the browser's row of icons.</li></ol> |

Click on checkbox next to "Navigator" under "Enable JavaScript for".</li><li>5. Click the "OK" button.</li><li>6. Close this window and Click the Reload button in the browser's row of icons.</li></ol>  |
